Virtual Ward Panels



Each Safer Neighbourhood Team has a flesh and blood ward panel made up of members of the local community who meet regularly with their local officers and help direct local police activity.

We understand that in this day and age such a time commitment is not possible for everyone. All you have to do is send an email to your local Safer Neighbourhood Team (contact email addresses over the page) saying you want to join their virtual ward panel.
